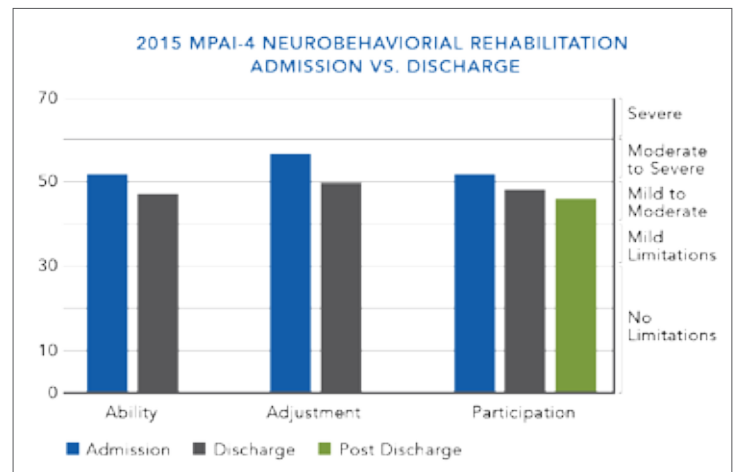
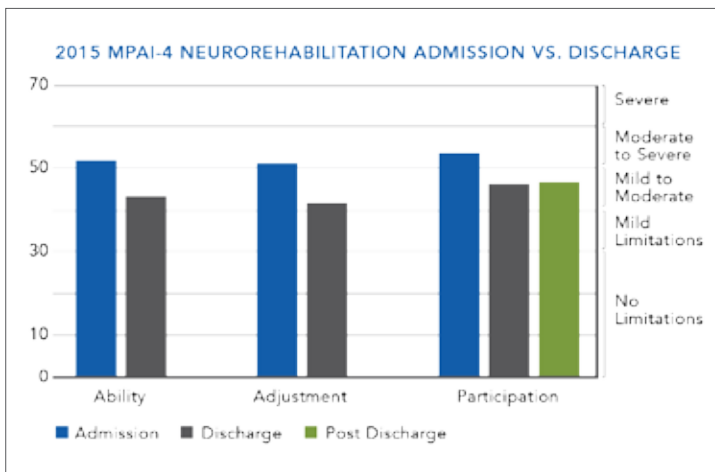


Since 1986, Learning Services has delivered outcome driven post-acute neurorehabilitation services for people with acquired brain injuries. With seven neurorehabilitation facilities strategically located across the country, Learning Services provides a wide range of specialized programs including neurorehabilitation, neurobehavioral, supported living and day treatment rehabilitation.

In 2015, 228 individuals were served across all programs.

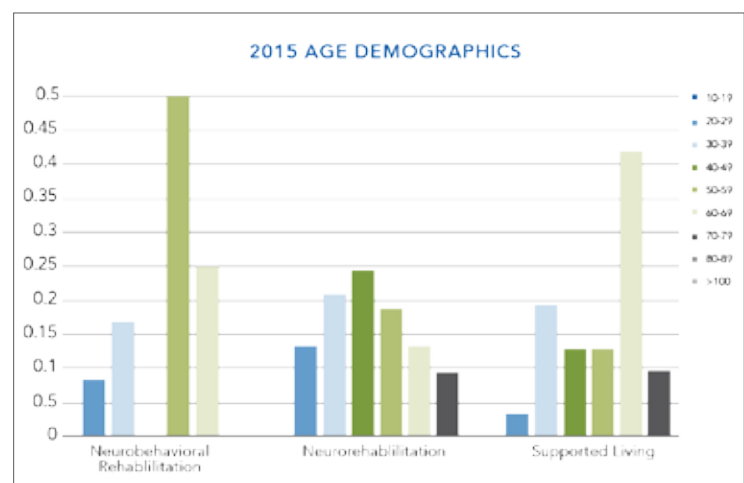
48% received comprehensive rehabilitation through neurorehabilitation, neurobehavioral or day treatment programs.

52% participated in supported living programs including residential and day activity services designed to sustain or improve level of functioning and quality of life.



## OUTCOME HIGHLIGHTS

- Participants in both neurorehabilitation and neurobehavioral levels of care reduced one level of disability from admission to discharge, with continued progress six months post-discharge.
- At time of admission, all participants were rated to have a moderate to severe level of disability.
- 66% of the neurorehabilitation participants were discharged home.
- 40% of the neurobehavioral participants were discharged home, while all others transitioned into a neurorehabilitation program.
- Age range included groups above 60 years of age, which is consistent with an aging work force and people staying active later in life.



## NATIONAL HIGHLIGHTS

- In 2015, Learning Services celebrated 30 years of providing post-acute neuro-rehabilitation services nationwide.
- 69% of the participants sustained work related injuries.
- 9% of the participants were active duty military or participants in the VA TBI Pilot Project.
- 87% were diagnosed as closed TBI.
- Average length of stay across all locations:  
*Neurorehabilitation—4 months*  
*Neurobehavioral—3 months*
- Learning Services North Carolina opened new residential facilities in Raleigh and Creedmoor, including the Brian Preston and Randy Evans Therapy Centers.
- Stakeholder Alignment of expectations were met with an overall high level of satisfaction.
- Learning Services provided innovative continuum of care partnerships with Neuro Net and Partners in Complete Brain Injury Care.
- All programs are CARF accredited with newly accredited Day Treatment programs.
