



## DAY TREATMENT REHABILITATION

Following an acquired brain injury, many individuals need help redeveloping cognitive, social, and functional daily living skills. The Learning Services Day Treatment Program provides customized rehabilitation services with the purpose of increasing an individual's independence with all tasks of daily living, community reentry, and leisure activities. Participants take part in a variety of therapeutic, social, and community-based activities designed to enhance their overall quality of life. We provide the participant and family education to ensure the transfer of skills into the home and problem-solve challenges as they arise. Our Day Treatment Program services are provided in a community setting where individuals can continue to participate in intensive rehabilitation during the day, returning home in the evening. Our transdisciplinary approach ensures that we address all aspects of rehabilitation—physical, social/interpersonal, cognitive, and emotional. Our goal is to restore each individual to his or her fullest potential of independence and meaningful activities at home, in the community, and in the workplace.
